MINISTER'S MESSAGE

14th May 2023

Future Focussed is one of our congregation's core values. On Monday night, the church council agreed on the following definition for Future Focussed.

We will constantly seek God's future plans and purposes, grateful that God has led us to this point. Inspired by the spirit we press forward.

As I think about this value, I'm reminded of Jesus' words in Matthew 16:18, "On this rock, I will build my church and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it."

The context of this passage is Peter's declaration of faith in Jesus as the Messiah. Jesus commends him for this. We are to fix our eyes on Jesus and his ministry and where that is leading. There are many other things that we can focus our attention on. Some of them are good and worthwhile. They could be the latest fad, or the thing that the church down the road is doing, or the brilliant idea that we came up with in church council. Apart from Jesus and his mission, we look in the wrong direction.

Future focussed means that we make decision based on what is yet to come, not what happened in the past. We learn from the past, we are shaped by the past, we celebrate the past, we remember the past. But we cannot repeat the past. The society we live in, our culture, attitudes, lifestyle have all moved. Therefore, the way we do ministry now needs to be continually adapting.

The business world often engages the concept of being future focussed. For them it is anticipating the next movement and acting on it now. Kodak was once the leading producer of cameras and camera film. It failed to look to the future and see the disruption to its business that digital photography would bring. The result is that they lost their dominance as they failed to move into the digital world.



What we offer is far more important than cameras and film. We are in the business of presenting the good news of Jesus Christ and drawing people into life in him.

Our task therefore is to remain open to what the Holy Spirit says to the church and where he calls us to act. As we do this we find an exciting world of new possibilities in faith, discipleship, ministry and mission open before us.

If is something that the church of God has done throughout the ages. The planting of churches in Ipswich, establishing Sunday Schools and Youth Groups, engaging in community outreach and so many other activities that we have done, have all been actions in the present that have looked to the future. As a future focussed church, we are asked to continually act now with an eye to what is yet to come.

Good news!!


